



Thank you for registering for the Paw Patrol Progressive Euchre Tournament Fundraiser at Down the Pike on February 3rd at 6pm!

Your willingness to participate allows us to continue to help dogs in the Dayton and surrounding areas. In 2017, Paw Patrol helped 245 dogs: 186 of which were taken into rescue and 59 were helped in the community in various ways. From all of the volunteers at Paw Patrol we thank you for your continued community support which allows us to continue to help the dogs within our community.

A bit of information regarding the Euchre Tournament:

- First hand to be dealt at 6pm
 - We encourage everyone to come early for drinks, food, and to ask questions about the event as well as the rescue!
- Upon arriving each person will be assigned a number and given a score card that will be your guide for the rest of the night
 - Make sure you check in at the Paw Patrol booth to receive this number.
 - **Please have your PayPal receipt available to check-in**
- 8 round tournament where every man/woman stands alone
 - Partners change each round as will your opponent and likely the table at which you will be seated
- Top 3 players will be determined by the FINAL total of the scores after the 8 rounds
 - First place: \$300
 - Second place: \$200
 - Third place: \$100
 - End of the night ties will be broken by the number of SUCCESSFUL loaners a player has across all 8 rounds
- A round will consist of 8 hands where each player at a table gets to deal twice
 - There are NO REDEALS- if the dealer catches that he/she misdeals he/she may redeal with no penalty as long as she/he catches it prior to flipping over the top card signaling the beginning of the hand
 - It is always STICK THE DEALER- if you're unsure what this means please have it clarified on the day of the tournament
- Scoring
 - 3 or 4 out of 5 tricks → 1 point
 - 5 out of 5 tricks → 2 points
 - Euchre → 2 points AND the team that made Trump or "got euchred" owes a \$1 team donation at the time of the Euchre
 - Loaner (one person takes 5 tricks) → 4 points
